It is only by committing to a path, remaining steadfast on that journey, sticking it out through thick and thin, marching shoulder-to shoulder with those who share our values and our vision that we can ever find that deep sense of joy, satisfaction and fulfillment in our lives.

My prayer for you, in this "month of love", is that you reflect on the beauty of being called to a life that exemplifies the love of Jesus. And, beyond that, the pleasure of living that life with others who are called to do the same. That you seek and enjoy the exhilaration of a faith community--people with whom you share the discouraging and the victorious seasons of life. Further, that you will invite others to do the same, so that you will all know satisfaction and fulfillment in your life!
